All Post-Doctoral positions include:

- Complete full and partial neuropsychological batteries to include diagnostic clarification and treatment planning
- Exposure to emotional, social, and personality patterns assessments
- Specialty areas (e.g., ASD, ADHD, Trauma, etc) can also be developed as cases can be assigned based on a candidate interest.
- Provide psychological services for a diverse group of patients in age (5 years thru adulthood) and presenting concerns, including anxiety, depression, trauma-related responses, ADHD, academic and behavioral difficulties, Autism Spectrum Disorders, and other social and emotional concerns
- Partner across a multi-disciplinary team to provide comprehensive psychological treatment
- Face-to-face individual supervision with a licensed clinical psychologist
- Group supervision of therapy cases with licensed clinical psychologists
